<u>Which Schools may Enter</u>: All Public & Private AHSAA member high schools from the City of Huntsville, the City of Madison and from Madison County.

<u>Awards:</u> Trophies for the top 3 teams and medals for the top 3 athletes per event will be given out. Top female & male point scorer will receive a personalized meet MVP trophy as well.

<u>Meet Officials</u>: A minimum of seven (7) AHSAA Officials, probably more, will be present each day of competition.... ALL schools are expected to provide at least 2 people (parent or student/ athlete) to assist certified officials at event.
